

Free Quilt Block Pattern

Block : Disappearing Nine Patch



Block 3: The Completed Block

Read instructions before beginning the project. All seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise stated.

This will be a very simple block for this month so I added a little twist to keep it interesting! Wait until you see the final results, it is simply amazing!

You will need neutral colored thread for stitching the block together.
Lower your stitch length 2.0 to create a tight stitch.
Press all seams open, to reduce bulk and make quilting easier.
A 14½" or 18½" square up ruler will come in handy also.

Fabric A: From your stash chose a fabric you like, cut 4 each 4 ½" squares, these will go in the corners.
(See block 1)

Fabric B: From your stash chose a fabric to coordinate with the A fabric cut 4 each 4 ½" squares for the remaining outside empty squares. (See block 1)

Fabric C: 1 Yellow block which I have provided for you. (See block 1)


Piece the rows together matching the seams.

Once your block is assembled, measure the block with your ruler and divide in half, side to side and top to bottom. (See block 2)


Rearrange the 4 sections follow the example so there are 2 yellow squares meeting at the corner points in the center and the other 2 yellow squares are at 2 opposite outside. (See block 3, the Completed block at the top of the page)

Put sashing strips on the right hand side and at the bottom with the yellow square in the corner
When your sashing is complete 2 yellow squares will meet corner to corner on the right hand side at the bottom. (See the completed block 3, the completed block at the top of the page)
