

Bulls Eye Quilt Block Comfort Quilt Block for September

This is a simple and great block to use up scraps. When we published these directions in June/July newsletter there were very few turned in. You have another chance. Please use juvenile prints.

You will need 1—9 X 9 inch square cut from beige tone on tone print for the background

1—8 X 8, 6 X 6, and 4 X 4 inch squares cut from bright prints.

Fold each of the 8", 6", and 4" squares in quarters and cut a quarter circle freehand.

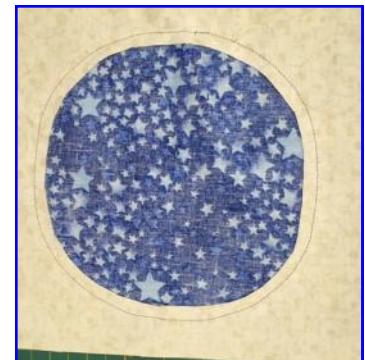
Center the large circle on the 9" background square.



Stitch around the circle, 1/4" from the raw edge.

Turn the block over and trim the background fabric inside the circle.

Center a medium circle on top of the large circle. Stitch around the medium circle, 1/4" from the raw edge. Turn the block over and trim the large circle within the stitching.



Center a small circle on top of the medium circle. Stitch around the small circle, 1/4" from the raw edge. Turn the block over and trim the medium circle within the stitching.
