## Nine Patch – Straight Furrows

This makes a 9 " block and a real scrap buster, which as we all know, means we can then buy more fabric.

Use a cream or off white background for the LIGHT squares. You may use any method you would like to create the 3  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch half square triangles. I like to start with a four inch square and then trim the resulting half square triangle to 3  $\frac{1}{2}$  inches.

Step One: Cut three DARK 3 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> inch squares

Cut three LIGHT 3 1/2 inch squares

Step Two: Create three half square triangles with a DARK and a LIGHT side.

Arrange the squares according to the picture.

Sew the squares together in rows, then the rows together to create your block.
