
Mr. Roosevelt's Necktie

This makes a 12 block. The comfort committee is in need of juvenile quilts so find some cute kid prints for your bowtie!


Use a white or white on white background for the LIGHT squares. You will need to cut

 $6 - 3 \frac{1}{2}$ " print squares and $8 - 3 \frac{1}{2}$ " white squares





Create 2 half square triangles with a print side and a white side using your favorite method for half square triangles. The two finished half square triangles need to measure $3 \frac{1}{2}$ "by $3 \frac{1}{2}$ ".



Arrange the squares according to the picture.

Sew the squares together in rows, then the rows together to create your block.
