## Calico Puzzle for January

The comfort Committee is giving us the go ahead to just create again for this first square of 2019. Please use an off white/cream color for your four squares. The center square and the surrounding pinwheels use a focus fabric of your choice. Then you can use some sort of coordinating fabric for the inside parts of the pinwheels.
To begin you will need $4-4 \frac{1}{2}$ inch squares of off white/ cream.
$1-4 \frac{1}{2}$ inch square of a focus fabric 2-5-inch squares of the focus fabric 2-5-inch squares of a coordinating fabric


Stack one 5-inch square of focus fabric and one 5 -inch square of coordinating fabric. Draw a diagonal line and sew a scant quarter inch on both sides of the line. Cut on the diagonal line to yield two half square triangles. Do the same thing with the other two 5 -inch squares. Trim the four half square triangles to measure $41 / 2$ inches.

Piece the block using the diagram. Be sure to rotate the half square triangles the same way as they are in the diagram.
Sew the squares together in rows and then sew the rows together.
