

Austin for February 2019

Again, we have the blessing of the Comfort Quilt Committee to create just a colorful square. No theme. You will need two contrasting prints and an OFF-WHITE background. From these fabrics you will cut:

- 4- 3 ½ inch by 6 ½ inch rectangles of OFF WHITE**
- 1- 6 ½ inch square of a focus fabric**
- 8 – 3 ½ inch squares of the focus fabric**
- 4 – 3 ½ inch squares of a coordinating fabric**



To make one flying geese unit, draw a diagonal line on the back of each of the 8-focus fabric 3 ½ in squares. Place one of these squares atop an OFF-WHITE rectangle, with the outer edges aligned. Sew just a bit inside the diagonal marking. Cut off the excess seam allowance. Press the remainder towards the corner. Repeat this with another focus fabric square on the other end of the rectangle.



Piece the block using the diagram. Sew the squares together in rows and then sew the rows together.

This pattern makes a 12-inch block. Enjoy!
