

SeeSaw for May and June

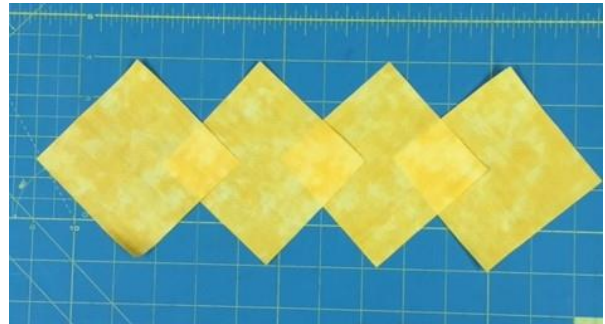
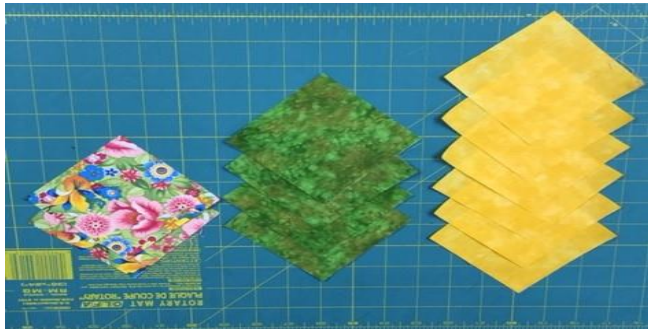
Again, we have the blessing of the Comfort Quilt Committee to create just a colorful square. No theme. You will need three fabrics for this square. One a BRIGHT color and two coordinating prints. I used a pattern and another color in the pattern

6- 3 7/8 in squares of the bright color *

4 – 3 ½ inch squares of the bright color

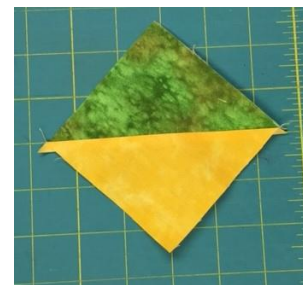
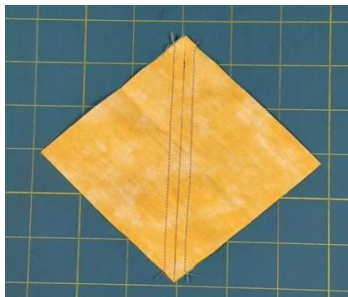
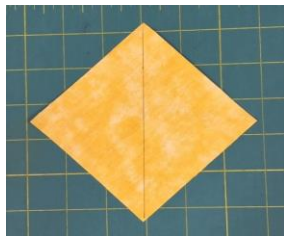
2 – 3 7/8-inch squares of the bright print (center of the Pinwheel) *

4 – 3 7/8-inch squares of the coordinating color (outside Triangles) *



The quilterscache pattern calls for 3 7/8-inch squares for the half square triangles. I always use four-inch squares and then trim them down.)

You will be making half square triangles with the print , coordinating color and the bright. 4 of the bright and print, and 8 of the bright and coordinating color.



Arrange the half square triangles as shown in the diagram. The Pinwheel goes in the middle with the (seemingly) flying geese as shown. The solid squares are the four 3 ½ inch squares from the cutting instructions. This makes a 12-inch block. I think a really bright and happy summer comfort quilt.
