## Shoofly

This pattern makes a 12 inch block. Use a cream or cream on cream color for the light squares and a rich color for the colored squares.

Create 4 half square triangles with a colored side and a cream side using your favorite method for half square triangles. The two finished half square need to be $4 \frac{1}{2}$ Inches by $4 \frac{1}{2}$ inches.


Cut four $4 \frac{1}{2}$ inch squares from the cream fabric and one $41 / 2$ inch square from the rich colored fabric.

Arrange your colored squares and half square triangles according to the diagram below.

Sew the squares in rows and then the rows together to make your shoofly square.

This square is "due" at the January 2018 meeting. So why not make a whole bunch from your stash?
