<u>2.) Other:</u> Includes Fiber Arts (Must contain fabric no hard frames), Home Decor (Ex. Table runners, place mats, very small quilts, pillows, ect.) and Wearables (ex. Vests, jackets, purses, totes, hats, aprons, ect.).

3.) Small: All quilts sizes UNDER 60"x60"

4.) Medium: All quilts sizes ranging BETWEEN 61" to 85"

5.) Large: All quilt sizes 86" and OVER

20 RIBBONS WILL BE AWARDED EACH CATEGORY WILL BE AWARDED FOR THE FOLLOWING:

- (4) First Place Overall for category
- (4) Best Pieced
- (4) Best Quilted
- (4) Best Appliquéd

** Except for the Guild Challenge, this has its own award voted on by members only.

SHOW AWARDS:

- (1) People's Choice Award
- (1) Chair Choice Award
- (1) Featured Quilter's Choice
- (1) *Quilt Guild Challenge Winner

PLEASE PRINT CLEARLY

Remember, a fellow quilter has to be able to read what you wrote.

- Turn in completed WHITE TOP PAGE by <u>April 1st.</u>
- <u>Safety Pin</u> YELLOW PAGE to the lower back of your quilt and fold your quilt

inside-out so that the Yellow Page shows and is easy to read.

- Bring in quilt to Clarkston High School on Friday between 3:00 & 6:00 pm.
- Save PINK PAGE and bring it when you pick up your quilt on Sunday,
- between 3:30 & 5:00 pm. You MUST turn in your Pink Page to receive your quilt.

The reasoning behind changing how we do categories is to help with properly identifying the quilts, we have a lot of confusion at check in between how many people made the quilts. This will also enable less ribbons. Most shows give ribbons to about 10% of the quilts entered, we were doing 45%. This makes winning a ribbon more prestigious and less expensive for the guild and less taxing on the ribbons makers. Thank you all for your comments as we make this change.
